PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Soft skills OUTside of school Learning environment (SOUL Skills) is a project aiming to provide information about the effects of the current social isolation in the European countries undertaken as a measure to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 pandemic on children between the age of 6 and 12. The partnership involves 7 entities from 6 countries with diverse, but complimentary, experiences, knowledge and qualifications in various educational levels. The main project idea is to offer scientific information to educators about the effects of social isolation due to Covid-19 on children's behavior and socialization. We are targeting to gain the know - how on evaluating the appearing deficits and directing the solutions.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- To identify the deficit in transferable skills development in children aged 6-12 years with focus on their development and proper assessment,
- To create a mechanism (descriptors) for joint evaluation of transversal skills of children aged 6-12,
- To design a set of methods - Toolbox for supporting development of these transversal skills.
